## COMMUNITY INVITED TO JERRABOMBERRA WETLANDS FAMILY FUN ON SUNDAY

Max Bourke, Chair, Capital Woodland and Wetlands Trust, today encouraged Canberrans to attend the Jerrabomberra Wetlands Family Fun Day, in celebration of World Wetlands Day.

“This free event will be held on Sunday 5 February, from 11 am to 2 pm. It will be a great way to spend time with the family in the beautiful setting of Jerrabomberra Wetlands,” Mr Bourke said.

“There will be a wide range of activities on offer including parachute games, a jumping castle, face painters, the Patting Paddock and the largest ibis bird you will ever see.

“Take a walk through the wetlands and enjoy unique wildlife in their natural habitat. Bring your binoculars to spot a variety of native birds and get some bird watching tips from the experts.

“You can also get up close and personal with a corroboree frog, talk to a Ranger, learn more about what it means to be a fire fighter in the ACT, and enjoy a guided bus tour to rarely seen sections of the wetlands.

“Pack a picnic for the family or enjoy the sausage sizzle and ice cream stall.

“This event also provides the opportunity to learn about the future plans for the Jerrabomberra Wetlands and promote the conservation of wetland habitats,” Mr Bourke said.
