REOPENING OF BELCONNEN INTERCHANGE

ACTION advises that the Belconnen Interchange has now reopened.

All bus services have returned to normal operations.

ACTION apologises for any inconvenience caused and thanks passengers for their patience.

The facts:

- An independent company has carried out an air quality assessment of the site yesterday.
- This report confirmed that there is no asbestos present.
- The reason for the temporary closure relates to the dislodgement of some fibreglass from the bus interchange roof structure.
- The relocation of the Belconnen Bus Interchange was a safety precaution only. This was due to overhead roofing fibreglass being dislodged during cleaning.
- Repairs were carried out over night.
- There was no immediate risk or danger to the public.
