

APPLICATION FOR AN ENVIRONMENTAL AUTHORISATION

Under Section 47 of the *Environment Protection Act 1997* (the Act), an Environmental Authorisation is required for the following Class A activities:

- a) Acceptance of soil
- b) Outdoor concert activities
- c) Motor racing events
- d) Sale and Supply of Firewood
- e) other Class A activities (refer to Schedule 1 of the Act)

Before you complete this application we suggest that you contact the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) by calling Canberra Connect on 13 22 81 to discuss the information you need to provide with your application. Firewood Applicants should be aware of the Standard Conditions which relate to their activity.

6. Provision of information

The EPA may request further information relevant to this application and such further information must be received by the EPA before the application can be processed. If further information is required, the EPA will contact you within 20 working days of receiving your application. The Applicant should supply to the EPA at the time of lodging this application any information in the possession of the Applicant relating to environment protection and monitoring measures undertaken or contemplated by the Applicant which will help the EPA to access the application.

7. Exclusion of material from public inspection

If you believe some or all of the information you supply to the EPA could reveal a trade secret or adversely affect a person's lawful business activities, you may apply under Section 21 of the Act for that information not to be made available for public inspection. (Describe any information which you believe should be excluded from public inspection).
