

## Animal Licence Categories and Costs

Issued: 28 September 2007

If you wish to keep animals that require a licence in the ACT, there are three licence categories:

- **Non-Commercial Fauna Licence (20 or less animals)**
- **Commercial Fauna Licence (greater than 20 animals)**
- **Protected Native Animal or Special Protection Status Species Licence (any number of these animals) i.e. ALL reptiles other than exempt species.**

### NON-COMMERCIAL FAUNA LICENCE (20 OR LESS ANIMALS)

- The licence is valid for five years from date of issue.
- This licence allows the keeping, import (into ACT), export (from ACT) and sale of animals other than Protected Native Animals and Special Protection Status Animals. Refer to the Protected Native Animals list and the Special Protection Status list at [www.tams.act.gov.au](http://www.tams.act.gov.au).
- At any one time the licence holder is not to have more than 20 animals in their possession.
- In a calendar year the import, export and sale of animals will only cover a maximum of 20 animals.
- The licence application fee for this licence is \$12.00.

### COMMERCIAL FAUNA LICENCE (GREATER THAN 20 ANIMALS)

- This licence is valid for five years from date of issue.
- This licence will be reviewed annually from the date of issue.
- This licence allows the keeping, import (into ACT), export (from ACT) and sale of animals other than Protected Native Animals and Special Protection Status Animals.
- The licence application fee for this licence is \$30.50.

### PNA/SPS FAUNA LICENCE (ANY NUMBER OF THESE SPECIES)

- This licence is valid for five years from date of issue.
- This licence will be reviewed annually from the date of issue.
- This licence allows the keeping, import (into ACT), export (from ACT) and sale of animals including Protected Native Animals and Special Protection Status Animals.
- The licence application fee for this licence is \$30.50.
