No longer available on paper, the e-map is now ready to download onto almost any portable device - which for most of us will mean our very clever mobile phones.

It's free. It's paperless. It's easily updated. It offers more information - more huts, walking & 4WD tracks, locked gates etc. And it's a breeze to use anywhere because once you've downloaded it onto your phone (use the scan block) you don't need an internet connection to use it.
