Guide to Campgrounds

Camping Permits

Bookings must be made in advance at the Namadgi Visitor Centre either in person or by phone or fax. Book early to secure a site, especially on long weekends.

Fees are payable in advance at the Namadgi Visitor Centre. This can be done on your way to the campground by:

- cash, cheque or credit card during open hours; or by
- cash or cheque using the after-hours facility at the front gate.

Your permit will include a tag to attach to your tent or campervan.

Organised groups

Sites for organised groups are available at Honeysuckle Campground. Please discuss your requirements when booking through the Namadgi Visitor Centre.

Campervans

Sites for campervans and vehicles with annexes are available at Honeysuckle campground. There is no provision for large caravans or campervans in the park. Please contact the Visitor Centre for nearby alternatives.

Three night limit

A three night limit applies at all Namadgi campgrounds.

Firewood

Campers are encouraged to bring gas or fuel stoves as an alternative to campfires. Fast burning firewood is supplied at all campgrounds but is not suitable for slow burning campfires. Twenty kilogram bags of slow burning wood are available for purchase at the Namadgi Visitor Centre. All proceeds support the *Koomarri Association*.

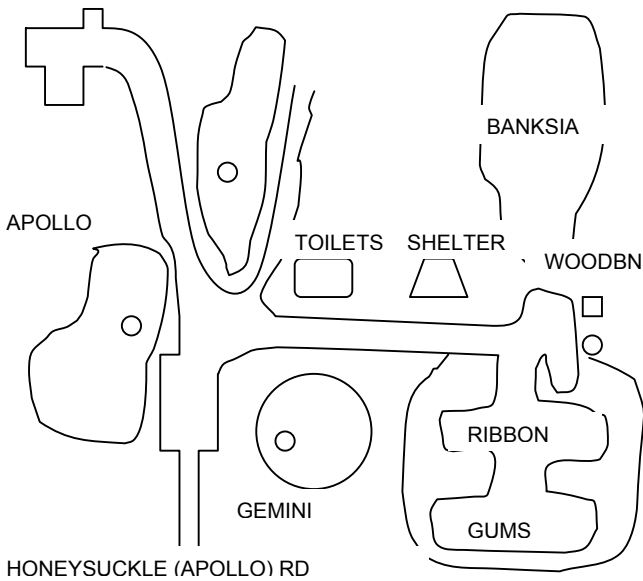
Collection of firewood from the surrounding bush is prohibited.

Fires may only be lit in the fireplaces provided. Please share your campfire as required. All fires, including gas or fuel stoves are prohibited during total fire ban days.

Please respect other campers. No noise after 9 pm.

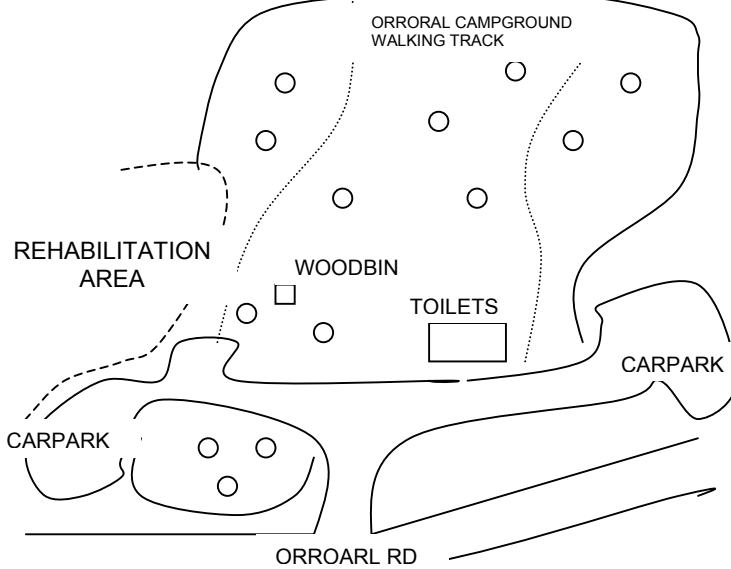
SITE OF FORMER

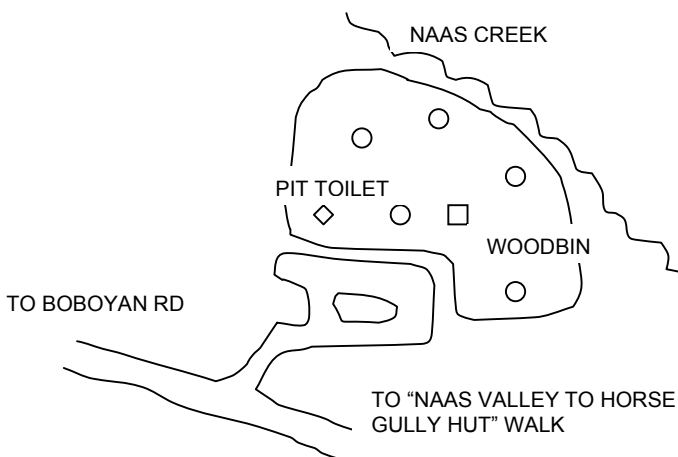
HONEYSUCKLE CAMPGROUND

- Shelter with communal fireplace, gas BBQ, tables – shared facility.
 - Camp within your allocated area.
 - **BANKSIA** – max four in party, small backpack tents only, no fires.
 - **RIBBON GUMS** – campervans, vehicles with annexes only.
 - **GEMINI, MERCURY** and **APOLLO** – for larger parties and organised groups, one shared fireplace for each.
 - Toilets are composting.
 - Please use rainwater and firewood conservatively.

ORROARL CAMPGROUND

- Maximum party of six people.
 - No organised groups.
 - Fireplace at each site.
 - Boil or treat stream water.
 - Please use firewood conservatively.
 - Flushing toilets.
- O = Shared fireplace (13)



MT CLEAR CAMPGROUND

- Maximum party of six people.
 - No organised groups.
 - Boil or treat stream water.
 - Please use firewood conservatively.
 - Pit Toilets.
- O = Shared fireplace (5)
