



Who can use bus lanes in the ACT?

Buses, taxis, public hire cars & motorcycles

A number of road lanes in the ACT have been declared as 'bus lanes'. Examples are the bus lanes on Adelaide Avenue and Belconnen Way. There are also a number of intersections where buses are given priority through the use of 'B lights'.

Under the Australian Road Rules and ACT regulations, taxis, public hire cars (not self-drive hire cars or rental cars) and motorcycles can also use a 'bus lane'.

Roads ACT have commenced a program to simplify signage and road markings at 'bus lanes'. The new signs will be consistent with other States and Territories.

Road users should also be aware that there are also some areas where only buses can go. These are signposted accordingly.
