

Penalties in excess of \$900 apply

Miniature Motorcycles and Motorised Scooters

These vehicles cannot be used on ACT roads or road related areas* unless:

- Registration and appropriate third party insurance is obtained; and
- Riders hold a motorcycle licence, wear an approved motorcycle helmet, ride only on the road and obey all road rules.

Registration is not available to vehicles that do not meet the applicable vehicle standards. You should be aware that, to date, no miniature motorcycles or motorised scooters have met the ACT requirements for registration.

Mobility aid scooters and electric wheelchairs are excluded from these requirements.

Unregistered vehicles may only be used on private property.

The current penalties for using an unregistered and uninsured vehicle on the road or road related area (including footpaths, bicycle lanes and bicycle paths) exceed \$900. Police urge anyone who sees miniature motorcycles or motorised scooters being ridden unlawfully to contact Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000.
