IMPORTANT CONDITIONS:

- General licence applicants should be **at least 15 years of age**. Applicants under that age should obtain the written consent of a parent or guardian who would be listed as the co-licence holder or they can nominate an adult family member (parent/guardian/older sibling) to hold the licence on their behalf. This ensures that the young applicant is recognised under the licensing system as gaining experience in support of future licence applications.
- Native animals and plants may only be obtained from legal sources (registered breeders and pet-shops). It is an offence to take native animals and plants from the wild or release native animals and plants to the wild without the written consent of the Conservator for Flora and Fauna.
- False or misleading information may incur a penalty under the Nature Conservation Act 1980.
- It is a condition of application that if deemed appropriate the Conservator of Flora and Fauna reserves the **right to inspect keeping arrangements** prior to licence being granted.
- **The outcome of an application cannot be predicted and should not be anticipated. A licence must be held prior to undertaking the activity.**
