## **TRAFFIC LIGHTS ON PIALLIGO AVENUE BECOME OPERATIONAL**

Traffic lights on the southbound section of Pialligo Avenue, near the Brindabella Circuit roundabout, become operational during this evening's peak period, Territory and Municipal Services has announced.

"The traffic lights are on the southbound Pialligo Avenue carriageway about 100 metres north of the Brindabella Circuit roundabout," said Tony Gill, Director, Roads ACT.

"They come into operation during this evening's peak period due to changes in the internal circulation at the Canberra International Airport which came into effect from today.

"These changes will mean that the majority of vehicles exiting Brindabella Business Park will now be using Brindabella Circuit and have to pass through the roundabout.

"As southbound traffic on Pialligo Avenue is the dominant movement, we need to create gaps in the traffic flow so that vehicles leaving Brindabella Business Park each weeknight can enter the roundabout.

"We will initially have the traffic lights on from 4.15 pm to 5.45 pm during the weekday evening peak, but will monitor how they work and make any necessary fine tuning."
