FOCUS GROUP FOR PEOPLE WITH A DISABILITY AND THEIR CARERS

Community Engagement and Communication Head Kylie McKinley today invited people with a disability and their carers to take part in a focus group currently being held by Territory and Municipal Services (TAMS).

“The goal of the focus groups is to get feedback on current TAMS services, so that we can seek to further improve them, and will include a brief overview on the range of services the Department provides,” said Ms McKinley.

“The focus groups will also explore better ways to attract potential employees to departmental workplaces.

“TAMS currently has an *Access Action Plan*, which outlines the range of initiatives it has in place to ensure its programs, services and workplaces are accessible to people with a disability. It is anticipated that the outcomes of the focus groups will contribute to inform the department’s next *Access Action Plan* and *Disability in TAMS – Workplace Action Plan*.

“There are currently spaces available for a focus group on Wednesday 7 November from 6pm.

“A summary of main themes emerging from the focus group will also be fed back to the community through the TAMS website,” said Ms McKinley.
